What has my child been doing this week?

Reception	Learning the letters and sounds 'M' 'D' 'G', creating patterns with Banana Bear and reading letters from 'The Monster'!
Year 1	Investigating the world's climate zones, finding out which plants can be used for food and amounts of money and change to 10p.
Year 2	Halves and quarters, ensuring we use capital letters for names and making some delicious fruit salads.
