What has my child been doing this week?

Reception	Learning about different types of farms, writing letters from the animals to Little Red Hen and talking about 3d shapes.
Year 1	Planning and writing our own adventure stories, finding out about springtime on Innes' farm, and finding halves and quarters of shapes and quantities.
Year 2	Watching and writing about The Tin Forest by Helen Ward, and exploring mini-beast habitats.
Year 3	Looking at scale and correspondence problems using multiplication, writing play scripts, and discovering how volcanoes produce igneous rock.
Year 4	Dividing numbers by 10 and 100, considering the different uses of rivers and enjoying our first swimming session.
Year 5	Working out equivalent fractions, looking at the difference between direct and indirect speech and writing fact files about famous pirates in history.
Year 6	Revising maths and English knowledge, designing resilient 'super-hero' selves and developing our rounders skills.
